Australian Bint Marscay boasts an outstanding pedigree. Her sire, Marscay, was 1981 Champion 2 Year Old and Champion Sire in Australia. Her stakes winner dam was an exceptional broodmare and daughter of Champion Sire Sir Tristram. Though her name may be nondescript (“Daughter of Marscay”), she proved herself in her own right. At two Bint Marscay won the Kindergarten Stakes, the Magic Night Stakes (G2) and the Golden Slipper Stakes (G1) in Australia. Her three year old campaign concluded with a win in the Chirnside Stakes (G2). In 10 races, mostly graded stakes, she won 4, got 2 seconds and 2 thirds for the equivalent of US \$1,034,821. Bint Marscay passed her talents down to her daughters Mannington (by Danehill) and Bollinger (by Dehere) and her son Sheraton (by Woodman), all graded stakes winners. Her success with American shuttle stallions led to importation from the Vinery’s Australian Farm to the US, but as she aged she could no longer carry a foal to full term and was retired to Old Friends. Among her grandchildren are Louisiana Derby winner Friesian Fire.
