2016 Commonwealth Derby winner Deeply Undervalued is a son of esteemed turf sire Kitten's Joy. Bred by Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings LLC, Deeply Undervalued was owned by Klaravich Stables, Inc. and William H. Lawrence and was trained by Chad Brown. He competed at Saratoga, Belmont Park, Laurel Park, Gulfstream Park, and Keeneland. He achieved his first win at age 3 on the Saratoga turf at a mile and 3/8 with jockey Irad Ortiz, Jr. In that race he demonstrated patience and tactical ability. Later that year he won the Commonwealth Derby at Laurel Park in Virginia, a turf run of 1 and 1/8 mile, negotiating traffic handily with Manuel Franco up. Deeply Undervalued retired from racing with 8 starts, 2 wins and 3 seconds for earnings of \$216,412. Old Friends is grateful to trainer Chad Brown—who most definitely did not “undervalue” this game athlete—for facilitating Deeply Undervalued's retirement with us.
